Week of Prayer for Christian Unity January 18 - 25, 2012

The **Week of Prayer for Christian Unity** is celebrated annually from January 18 (traditional feast of St. Peter) through January 25 (feast of St. Paul). The observance is sponsored by the World Council of Churches and the Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity of the Catholic Church. During this week-long observance, and throughout the year, Christians are invited to gather with their Christian neighbors to join in prayer for Christian Unity. Pentecost is also an appropriate time to plan an ecumenical prayer service

Churches in a different part of the world prepare the theme and prayer service for the Week of Prayer. The 2012 theme: "**We will all be changed by the Victory of our Lord Jesus Christ**" is from 1 Corinthians Chapter 15 – Verses 51-58. It was developed by churches in Poland who decided to focus on a theme concerned with the transformative power of faith in Christ, particularly in relation to our praying for the visible unity of the Church, the Body of Christ.

The Office for Ecumenical and Interreligious Affairs of the Archdiocese of Chicago is encouraging all Christians to engage in personal prayer and join local joint observances during the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity and throughout the year.
