Today's Gospel story (Lk 9:28-36) would make a dramatic movie scene! Jesus' friends are dozing off up on a mountain until they see Jesus completely transformed. At this, Peter, James and John become "fully awake" and they proclaim, "Master, it is good that we are here."

Over the last two months there have been many people who have experienced a kind of transformation of their own...these are the people who have returned to the Catholic Church during the **Catholics Come Home** evangelization initiative. Many returning Catholics began by going to the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time in years during January and February.
