### Love

was not true for Saint Paul who had a powerful and life-transforming experience of love: “I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me” (Gal 2:20). Every time Paul celebrated the Eucharist, he knew that love anew when he heard Jesus’s great words: “This is my body, which will be given up for you.”

In Sunday Mass we meet the living Jesus who loves us to the utmost unchanged. Nothing else can matter as much. In loving us, Jesus transforms our lives giving himself up for us. When we truly know and believe his self-sacrificing love made present and real in the Mass, we are forever .

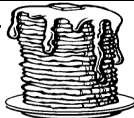
