When the ship that bore you to trial in Rome was on the verge of shipwreck and the sailors were despairing, you assured them that they would not lose even a hair of their heads—help me to meet the devastating circumstances of my life with a hope that is steadfast, certain, and firm.

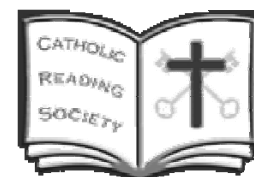
