**Community Thanksgiving Prayer Service

This year St. Florian will host the Thanksgiving Ecumenical Prayer Service on Wednesday, Nov. 24th at 7PM. With our neighbors from St. Columba and Lebanon Lutheran, we will pray and sing in a spirit of thanks. We would also appreciate donations of non-perishable food items and monetary contributions to assist the St. Vincent De Paul pantry at St. Florian. Then join us afterwards for fellowship and refreshments in Konsowski Hall.

This year our Thanksgiving prayer service will be prayed in the spirit of Taizé. Pronounced "Teh-zay," it is named for a town in France where Brother Roger, recently deceased, founded a religious community. The community began during World War II protecting the Jewish people and others who were being persecuted. A prayer form developed there which has become very popular in recent years. Its music is composed of short, repeating refrains, similar to "mantra" traditions in some other faiths. The service is intended for ecumenical gatherings. We invite everyone to join us for an evening of calming, relaxing music with scripture, candles, and community. All of this is done in a spirit of sharing and thanksgiving.
