The groups will meet three times per week as follows: Monday 6:00 - 7:00pm, Thursday 6:00 - 7:00pm, and Saturday from 10:00 - 11:00 am.

Our self defense program is a system of countermeasures designed to instruct the students on how to defend themselves against a wide array of potential attacks as well as multiple opponent situations. This is an ongoing program, and students will work towards rank. Students are required to wear uniforms during class. We get these uniforms at a reduced cost. We also educate the children and youth in other areas such as physicality, situational awareness, focus and discipline.
