We're happy to announce our new St. Florian's Kids Self Defense program beginning Monday, November 2, 2015 in Konsowski Hall at St. Florian's. The program is designed for kids ages 5 - 17.

The groups will meet three times per week as follows: Monday 6:00 - 7:00pm, Thursday 6:00 - 7:00pm, and Saturday from 10:00 - 11:00 am.

Our self defense program is a system of counter-measures designed to instruct the students on how to defend themselves against a wide array of potential attacks as well as multiple opponent situations. This is an ongoing program, and students will work towards rank. Students are required to wear uniforms during class. We get these uniforms at a reduced cost. We also educate the children and youth in other areas such as physicality, situational awareness, focus and discipline.

Outside of the group program, we also offer personal training in self defense.

As an introductory offer to St. Florian school students or kids from the church, we are happy to extend a one week complementary free pass.
