KNOW THE MASS, ONE WORD AT A TIME

Remember

Every Mass remembers the Death and Resurrection of Jesus, but not as you would expect. Most of our day-to-day talk about remembering really means recalling or bringing up something that happened in the past. Our remembering at Mass is much, much different. It is not a matter of recall, but rather of making present — here and now — what we remember. The Mass doesn't just commemorate the Death and Resurrection of Jesus as a past event. The Mass makes this event present to us, right now, right here, in sign and sacrament. Our remembering in the Mass enables us to be present to him — right here and right now — as the self-sacrificing Lord who destroys death and restores life.

Each one of the Eucharistic prayers has an *anamnesis*, or a special prayer of remembering. So, for example, the priest prays in Eucharistic Prayer IV: "Therefore, O Lord, as we now celebrate the memorial of our redemption, we remember Christ's Death and his descent to the realm of the dead, we proclaim his Resurrection and his Ascension to your right hand. . . ." And in our prayer of remembering, we don't just recall Jesus, we meet him as the dying and rising Lord who draws us into new life.

Recordar

Cada Misa recuerda la Muerte y Resurrección de Jesús, pero no como Usted podría esperar. La mayoría de las veces que platicamos sobre los recuerdos, en realidad, tratamos de repasar o evocar algo que sucedió en el pasado. Nuestro recordar en la Misa es muy diferente. No se trata de evocar sino de hacer presente —aquí y ahora- lo que recordamos. La Misa no conmemora la Muerte y Resurrección de Jesús como un evento pasado. La Misa nos hace presente ese evento, al instante, aquí mismo, en signo y sacramento. Nuestro memorial en la Misa nos capacita para estar presentes ante él —aquí y ahora-, ante el Señor que se entrega venciendo la muerte y restaurando la vida.

Cada una de las plegarias eucarísticas contiene una anamnesis, o una plegaria especial de recuerdo. Así, el sacerdote en la Plegaria Eucarística IV, ora: "Por eso, Padre, al celebrar ahora el memorial de nuestra redención, recordamos la muerte de Cristo y su descenso al lugar de los muertos, proclamamos su resurrección y ascensión a tu derecha . . ." Y en nuestra oración de recuerdo, no evocamos a Jesús, lo encontramos como el Señor que muere y resucita y que nos conduce a la vida nueva.
