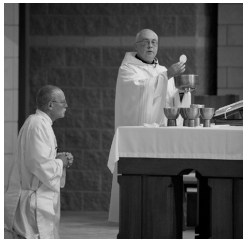

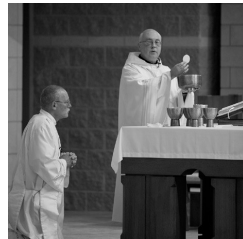
## KNOW THE MASS, ONE WORD AT A TIME

### Keep

In his first letter to the Corinthians, Saint Paul preserves the words of Jesus at the Last Supper: "This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me" (1 Corinthians 11:24). The action of doing and saying what Jesus said and did at the Last Supper is an act of remembrance that recalls and makes present his saving mysteries. This action also keeps or holds the mystery of his Death and Resurrection close to us.

When we keep the mystery in our worship and in our lives, we can draw its saving power into ourselves and into the circumstances that we daily meet. Even more, we keep the Eucharistic mystery not just to hold onto it for ourselves but to be ready to share it with others. When forces of death or sin seem overwhelming for us or for others, we draw from the mystery that we have kept from the celebration of the Eucharist.

**NEW MASS TIMES**

As of **June 1, 2013** our **DAILY MASS** (Monday through Saturday) will begin at **7:30 am**. The only exception would be Friday, June 7, 2013, last day of school, at 8:15 am. Church doors will be opened at 6:45 am.

**Mass Intentions**

Any Catholic may offer up the Mass in which he or she participates for any good intention. Certainly, graces will accrue in accordance with the intensity of that person's participation and sincerity. However, the custom of requesting a priest to offer the Mass for a specific intention, even when one cannot be physically present at the Mass, is a longstanding tradition in the Church. This is because the Church considers the Mass as the greatest possible prayer of intercession insofar as it is the perfect offering of Christ to the Father by making present the paschal mystery of his death and resurrection. The faithful generally make an offering, called a stipend, to the priest in order to apply the Mass to a specific intention. By making this offering, the faithful, by parting with something that is their own, associate themselves more intimately with Christ who offers himself in the sacred Host, and obtain thereby more abundant fruits. Thus, in normal circumstances, a priest may only accept one stipend for any one Mass even though he may offer up the Mass for several intentions.

### Respect Your Flag Important Things to Remember

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag should be rendered by standing at attention facing the flag with the right hand over the heart. When not in uniform, men should remove their headdress with their right hand and hold it at the left shoulder, the hand being over the heart. Persons in uniform should remain silent, face the flag, and render military salute.

Display the U.S. flag on all days but especially on national and State holidays and other days that may be proclaimed by the President of the United States. On Memorial Day, the U.S. flag should be half staffed until noon.

The U.S. flag should be displayed on or near the main building of every public institution, during school days in or near every schoolhouse, and in or near every polling place on election days.

Always hoist the U.S. flag briskly. Lower it ceremoniously.

Never in any way should any disrespect be shown to the U.S. flag.

When the U.S. flag is in such condition that is no longer a fitting emblem for display, it should be destroyed in a dignified way, preferably by burning.
