Recognize

When the risen Jesus approached the two disciples on their way of Emmaus, they did not recognize him. After he opened God's Word for them and then took bread, blessed it, and broke it, Saint Luke says: "Then their eyes were opened, and they recognized him" (Luke 24:31). Since that time, every Mass has been an act of recognition.

At Mass, we recognize that we do not walk alone. We recognize the presence of the Risen One who even now is transforming our fragile and vulnerable existence and drawing us into the fullness of life. We recognize the presence of the Lord, as we make our Eucharistic acclamation: "We proclaim your Death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection until you come again." We recognize his presence among us and his glory in the Most Holy Trinity when acclaim the Great Amen, affirming "Through him, and with him, and in him, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor is yours, for ever and ever. Amen."

Reconocer

Amén".

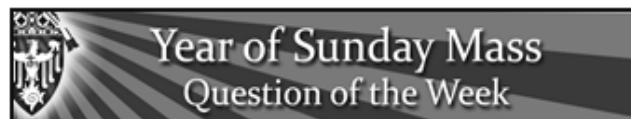
