**STATEMENT OF FRANCIS CARDINAL GEORGE, O.M.I.
Regarding the canonization of Blessed Popes
John XXIII and John Paul II
July 5, 2013**

The canonization of blessed Popes John XXIII and John Paul II will be a joyful moment. The history of the Church is the story of holiness. It is a centuries long saga of disciples growing ever closer to the Lord. Both Popes now join the great chorus of those recognized publicly as friends of the Lord, witnesses to the transforming power of God's grace active in human lives. This canonization will encourage everyone to stay on the path of discipleship.

Strategic Plan Year 3 – Year of Strong Catholic Parents

The third year will focus on fostering deeper connections with parents, particularly when they present their children for sacraments. This year may include some of the following elements: 1. Creating sacramental programs for parents that include a deep understanding of the sacraments. 2. Highlight parents' responsibility to raise their children in the faith. 3. Encourage parental involvement over time (participants one year become the volunteer leaders the next year). 4. Retreats or other programs for parents that encourage deeper reflections on their faith life and their role as models for their children. 5. Encourage parents to reconnect with their faith and provide them with home-based guidance to raise their children in the faith

I am writing this note to thank those who have contributed to the public debate on genderless marriage by speaking clearly to the fact that men and women are not interchangeable. I recognized that biological and cultural fact when I addressed this note to “brothers and sisters,” instead of assuming that “brothers” covers the entire human race.

This obvious fact was forgotten or ignored by the Supreme Court last week. Civil law doesn't change biological fact, however, and everyone knows that fathers and mothers are not interchangeable in the begetting and raising of children. “Same-sex marriage” is a contradiction in terms. Someday everybody will recognize that again. In the meantime, we must respect individuals, no matter their sexual orientation, and we must work to protect the authentic meaning of marriage in law. Algún día, todo el mundo va a reconocer eso de nuevo.
